The Hospitality Area will be located close to the Conference Room. It will be a relaxing place to build relationship during the coffee breaks and between the Conference sessions.

Since individual rooms will be used, Hospitality Room sponsors are allowed to have equipment, demos etc... in their room. They must however meet hotel requirements for access, loading etc...

There will be only 7 hospitality rooms, they hence will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis at a cost of 1000€ each due to PCIC Europe and to be ordered via the order form available on the website.

The hotel will provide an open bar located close to the Mirror room during the opening hours of the hospitality area as indicated in the conference program. The hotel will organize a system of tickets which will be used to pay for drinks. Each company having a hospitality room will receive tickets and will be billed based on their use. Unused tickets will not be charged. The bar will offer alcohol (96K / 12€), wine (73K / 9€), beer (59K / 7€) and soft drinks (45K / 5.5€) and will keep track of the amount to be billed for each hospitality room. The open bar will be directly between the hotel and the hospitality room companies and will not involve PCIC Europe in any way.

All additional costs related to the use of the space shall be at the sponsor expenses (furniture, decoration, etc ...) and be discussed directly with the Hotel while booking.

Please note: only Sponsors are eligible for an Hospitality Room, they must be registered at the conference.
